Nature:

LEATHEROL-SK is a raw oil which is non-ionic used as leather fatliquoring agent and is based on synthetic substitutes for Neatsfoot oil.

Behaviour:

LEATHEROL-SK is free oil can be used with other anionic fatliquors as a free component and is specially recommended for glacekid and uppers which require a certain amount of temper. It is a free oil component for pure white leathers due to its excellent light fastness and lack of colour. This oil is substitute for "neats of oil" This oil tend to deposit more on the surface of leather and give sleek handle to the grain. It's excessive use (More then 2% on the shaved weight) might make it necessary to "clear" the grain to ensure proper adhesion of the finish. However in glace kid type leathers the quantity of oil used is so small that it will not create any such problems in the finishing. This oil has very good filing properties. This oil does not impart any disagreeable odour to the leather even after long storage. This oil gives very good setting property to leather.

Application:

LEATHEROL-SK is used as a free oil component in the conventional manner for glacekid and upper leathers. The quantity to be used will depend on the type of

leathers, thickness, amount of retanning or filling imparted and the power of self emulsifiable oil used to emulsify free oils. Both oils when used in the fatliquor have properties to impart a high gloss to the finish, especially in glazable finishes.
